Advent greetings filled with Hope!

As we prepare to celebrate Holy / Missionary Childhood Sunday, which coincides with the Feast of Sto. Niño here in the Philippines on 19 January 2025, we reflect on the inspiring words of Pope Francis: "There are so many gifts, so many riches that children bring to humanity. Children are in and of themselves a treasure for humanity and also for the Church, for they constantly evoke that necessary condition for entering the Kingdom of God: that of not considering ourselves self-sufficient, but in need of help, of love, of forgiveness." (General Audience, 18 March 2015)

In this Jubilee Year of Hope, let us recognize the extraordinary role of children — not only as recipients of care but as carriers of hope, inspiring and joining us in building a new, more humane, just and peaceful world. Pope Francis reminds us of the countless children worldwide who live in challenging conditions — those battling illness, enduring hunger, experiencing violence, or being cruelly robbed of their childhood due to war, poverty, and exploitation. Their voices, filled with suffering yet yearning for goodness, call us to concrete action and remind us of our shared responsibility to truly care for one another. (cf. With this spirit of hope and mission, I most respectfully request Your Excellency to issue a Circular Letter encouraging clergy, religious, laity — and especially children — to offer prayers, sacrifices, and material support for children in need nationwide and worldwide.
